



\$1,000 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Catholic Vantage Financial supports higher learning and career readiness. As a strong supporter of education and a leader in the Catholic community, we will award four (4) scholarships valued at \$1,000 each, to graduating high school seniors from the class of 2019 who are members of this credit union. Please read all of the eligibility requirements, requested documents, and important dates before submitting your application. Information received will be reviewed for accuracy. Scholarships will be awarded based on the information submitted. Judges' decisions will be final.

ELIGIBILITY

- Students must be a primary member with at least a \$5 balance. Applications will not be accepted unless account is open.
- Must be a high school senior who will be graduating in the spring of 2019.
- Limit one scholarship application per student. Student family can only receive one Catholic Vantage Financial Scholarship.
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50.
- If awarded a scholarship, recipient must submit copy of most recent report card to support GPA.
- Must plan on attending an accredited college, university, or trade school. Scholarship checks will be disbursed directly to the school.

At Catholic Vantage Financial, we believe that providing financial education to young people can help to influence good financial habits. We'd like to hear from you what is the best way for credit unions to help young people navigate the financial journey. Please provide a single spaced typed essay of no less than 500 words and no more than 2,000 words to let us know more about how young adults entering college are dealing with financial matters. For example, we'd like to hear about the following:

- Talk about what experience or person has most influenced your understanding and level of confidence for managing your finances. How will this help you achieve your academic, career, and financial goals?
- Do you feel that you and your friends have a good understanding of money matters? Why or why not, and what could we do to make a difference for you, your friends and classmates?
- What is the best way to reach out to young people and get their attention?
- Looking ahead to the next 2 to 4 years, what is your plan for managing money and expenses? What resources, tools and banking products do you see yourself using to help you.
